When do we qualify?

Applications will be reviewed and processed as soon as possible. Please allow time before your event to receive approval. Please complete the outline of your budget for our records. The cultural grant can be applied from September to June of each school year. **Multiple requests will be approved depending upon funds available.** At least two weeks prior to your activity/event, complete the attached application form and forward it to:
